TO THE RESIDENTS OF OYSTER BAY-EAST NORWICH,

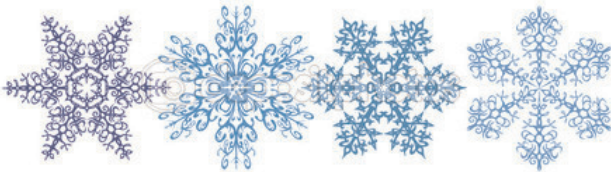
