Simply follow these steps:

1. Go to www.oysterbaylibrary.org
2. Click on "Calendar" tab
3. Choose the date of the event from the calendar on the upper right hand corner
4. At the event you wish to register for, click on the "Register" button
5. Type in your OBEN Public Library Card 14 digit number
6. Fill out a short form and submit
